UNCTAD, in partnership with UNDP, is seeking a qualified National IT Specialist for the Automated System for Customs Data (ASYCUDA World) project in Vientiane. The National IT Specialist will be based in the UNCTAD-ASYCUDA World Project Office (UAWPO) at the Lao Customs Department (LCD) in Vientiane. The National IT Specialist will be required to undertake the following tasks in coordination with the Residents UNCTAD Experts and the NPT Members and the Lao Customs Department and the ICT Division Management as described below.

Duties and responsibilities

- Assist National Project Team Members and ICT staff with the synchronizing between ASYCUDA World Database and C2000 Database
- Advise and participate if require in the development or interface between ASYCUDA World and TAIS, ASYCUDA World and Treasury System, AW and Master Plan Control System
- Train and assist ICT staff with the development and production of user-defined reports and other reports
- Train and assist ICT staff with configuration and implementation of communication setup for electronic lodgment
- Train and assist ICT staff with development of supplementary modules, as required, and with seamless integration with ASYCUDA World standard package
- Assist with sizing of technical configuration for efficient operations of ASYCUDA World (roll out equipment)
- Provide expertise and support with regard to the ASYCUDA World Server engine.

Qualifications and experience

Mandatory:

- Master's degree or equivalent in Computer Science or related field
- Excellent working knowledge of operating systems including Windows and Unix/Linux
- Good working knowledge of networking and network administration
- At least 3 years experience in programming with Unix shell, C language, and RDBMS, such as Oracle or SYBASE MYSQL
- Experience in JAVA programming is mandatory and certification in JAVA programming will be an advantage
- Excellent working knowledge of Structured Query Language (SQL)
- Experience with client server applications
- Languages: A perfect working knowledge of English and Lao.

Desirable:

- Experience in Customs System, or similar revenue-collecting agencies, would be an asset
- Experience in ASYCUDA project implementation would be an asset
- Experience in system analysis and design
