

# Reporting on Human Development

## STRENGTHENING CAPACITY FOR NATIONAL HUMAN DEVELOPMENT REPORTING



### Description

UNDP supports the Government in developing the understanding of the concept of human development and its challenges in the Lao PDR, through the process of preparing the National Human Development Reports (NHDRs). This includes research and analysis as well as setting appropriate dissemination strategies and outlining the advocacy tools through which the main findings of the reports can be used to raise public awareness and be integrated into policy discourse. The intervention also looks into the sustainability of the production of the NHDRs and its related development processes.

### Main Objectives and Activities

#### Main Objectives

- Capacity strengthening for human development reporting;
- Successful production of National Human Development Reports;
- Development and Implementation of dissemination strategies and advocacy tools.

#### Main Activities in 2010

- To successfully produce and publish the 4<sup>th</sup> NHDR in English and Lao language.
- To implement an effective dissemination strategy and produce advocacy tools for the 4<sup>th</sup> NHDR that are appropriate to the theme of the report and the target audience.
- Initiate a new programme of support to the Department of statistics and explore the possibility of including the future support to the production of NHDRs within this programme.

- Key interim results
  - English and Lao versions of the 3<sup>rd</sup> NHDR on the impact of International Trade on Human Development have been produced, launched and successfully disseminated in 2008
  - Adaptation of DevInfo 5.0 into a national statistical database version 5.0 in partnership with UNICEF
  - The 4<sup>th</sup> NHDR on the Employment and Livelihoods in Lao PDR is currently in the final stages of production
  - There is strong ownership and commitment from the Government through the system of co-authorship of the NHDR and the wide participation through the Board of the project from involved ministries such as Ministry of Planning and Investment, Ministry of Education and Ministry of Labour and Social Welfare.
  - Developed targeted advocacy and communication tools for effective dissemination of the NHDR to the public and policy makers
